Kate is a Canadian actor, playwright, teacher and director. *THE LAST WIFE* premiered at the Stratford Festival in 2015 and has

had many productions across Canada and the United States, before making its Australian premiere. *THE VIRGIN TRIAL* premiered at Stratford, won the Carol Bolt Award for Best New Play 2017, and was short-listed for the Governor General's Literary Award for Drama. *MOTHER'S DAUGHTER* premiered at the Stratford Festival in June 2019 and is now enjoying a sold out run. Kate's translation and adaptation of *CYRANO DE BERGERAC* is now playing at the Shaw Festival. Kate is the Associate Artistic Director of the Shaw Festival. She will be directing *HOLIDAY INN* for the Shaw winter season in 2019.

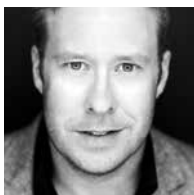
