In 2016 she was the recipient of the 2016 Balnaves Foundation Indigenous Playwright's Award, and in 2018 she directed a development of THE FEVER AND THE FRET for the Ensemble Theatre. Ursula is the voice of 'Levi' in the NITV/SBS children's animated TV series, LITTLE J & BIG CUZ, on which she is also a writer. Her impressive film credits include Wayne Blair's TOP END WEDDING, Baz Luhrmann's AUSTRALIA, Ivan Sen's GOLDSTONE and Ray Lawrence's JINDABYNE. 
